Things to know about IIPA Membership and Membership Policies

Benefits of IIPA Membership:

- All members have access to the IIPA blog. The Blog provides an on-line platform for members to share ideas about clinical practice and theory, and discuss personal and professional issues related to IP and clinical practice. The Blog also provides information about up-coming conferences, workshops and books. In order to provide a safe and confidential space for members to connect and communicate with one another, ***the Blog is available to members only.***
- Members are offered discounts on registration for IIPA biennial conferences.
- Annual membership is required in order to maintain an “active” status and certification in the IIPA as a Certified International Integrative Psychotherapy Psychotherapist/Counselor (CIIP/C), or Certified International Integrative Supervisor/Trainer (CIIPT/S).
- “Active” status as a CIIPT/S is also required to participate in evaluations of candidates presenting for certification as either a CIIP/C or CIIPT/S at our biannual conferences and/or other venues.

Membership in IIPA demonstrates support for all endeavors related to representing, promoting and maintaining the theory and philosophy of Relationally Focused Integrative Psychotherapy throughout the world. Membership dues support:

- Biennial international conferences and the provision of enriching educational workshops and social events.
- The IIPA Blog.
- Publication of the “*International Journal of Integrative Psychotherapy*” – the official on-line journal of the IIPA, where we publish articles on the theory and practice of Relationally Focused Integrative Psychotherapy, and other articles on the forefront of psychotherapy practice and education
- Costs related to the maintenance of our organization and our on-line platforms.

The leadership of the IIPA, and its members, do not receive any financial profit from the collection of annual dues.

Payment of Annual Dues:

Dues are payable on January 1st of each year. Dues that remain unpaid after March 1st of each year, will be assessed a late fee of 25 euros.

The current dues for 2020 are:

- CI IPTS & CI ICTS member: 200 €
- CI IPTS-UT & CI ICTS-UT member: 185€
- CI IP & CI IC member: 185 €
- Regular member: 65€
- Retired member: 50 €

On-line Dues Payment

All dues are collected through a secure on-line portal on our website: www.integrativeassociation.com.

To pay your dues:

If you are an active member:

- Enter in your personal account in "My Account" tab on Homepage.
- Then click on "Renew membership".

For new members:

- Create your own account in "Join the IIPA". Make sure to click on the box that represents your appropriate level of membership.

Policies Regarding the Non-Payment of Dues:

In order to maintain the professional integrity and quality of the IIPA, the following policy will apply to the non-payment of dues.

Dues are required to be paid at the beginning of each calendar year.

Unpaid dues will result in:

- A late fee of 25 euros will be incurred after March 1st of the current calendar year, to be paid in addition to the required dues.
- Temporary suspension of active membership status until dues and late fees are paid.
- Temporary removal from access to the blog until dues and late fees are paid.
- For advanced members, a temporary "inactive" status as an IIPA Certified Psychotherapist/Counsellor (CIIP or CIIC) or Certified Trainer/Supervisor (CI IPTS) until past (and current) dues and late fees have been paid.

- Conference discounts are only available to members who have remained current with their dues payments for at least one year prior to a conference.
- Individuals who are ***first-time members*** will be eligible for conference discounts if their membership begins during a conference year.

Loss of IIPA Certification

After three years of non-payment of dues, members who are IIPA Certified Psychotherapists/Counsellors (CIIP or CIIC) or IIPA Certified Trainers/Supervisors (CIPTS) will forfeit their certification status with IIPA, and will be required to apply and present for a re-evaluation in order to have their certification reinstated
